Student Dress Code Policy Reminders

Reminder that students are no longer permitted to wear shorts to school. Beginning October 19th, all students are to wear pants: Grades K - 5: Navy and Grades 6-8: Khaki

The pants must be dress slacks made of cotton-twill material similar to a pair of "Dockers" cotton-twill pants. Students may NOT wear pants made of stretchy/spandex material or cargo pants with pockets on the outside.

Ladies in grades K-5 may still wear skirts, but must wear leggings that are black, navy, or white underneath and leggings must come to the ankle.

Also a reminder regarding sweatshirts and sweaters:

- **K-8 -May wear navy blue, black or white sweater (button up or pull over) with no logo (school uniform shirt must be worn underneath)**
- **School uniform sweatshirts (with St. Mark Catholic & Lion embroidered) are the only sweatshirts (black or gray) with a logo that are approved**
