What's in a lunch?

- Entree
Daily Menu Selection or
Chicken Patty Sandwich (K-8) or
Chicken Nuggets or
Peanut Butter/Jelly Sandwich or
Lunchie Munchie (yogurt, cheese stick, wg muffin & wg goldfish crackers)

- Salad Bar with fresh fruits and vegetables available each day

- 1% White Milk (PK-8) or
Fat Free Chocolate (K-8) or
Fat Free Strawberry (K-8)

How much does a lunch cost?

- Student Lunch \$2.85
- Reduced Lunch 40¢
- Milk 45¢
- Adult Visitor Lunch \$3.50

(Free/Reduced Students milk by itself without lunch is 45¢)

How Do I Pay for Lunch?

- Pay online using MealTime Online.
- Send cash or a check (made payable to "St. Mark School") with your student. Clearly mark any payments you send to the school so the payment can be identified. Encourage your student to turn in payments to their homeroom teachers at the **beginning** of the day.
