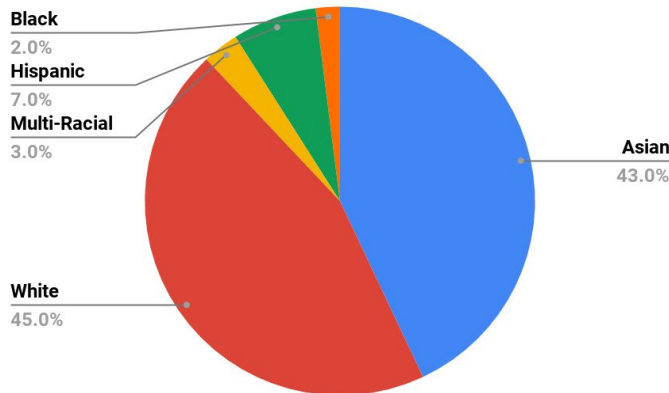




St. Mark Catholic School Fact Sheet

- One of the fastest growing school in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis with currently 395 students in grades Pre-K through 8th grade
- Two classes per grades for Pre-Kindergarten through 8th grade
- 50 teachers, staff, and administrators
- 70% of student attending St. Mark Catholic School are Catholic
- 36% of students are in the ESL (English as a second Language) program
- 5% of students have special needs
