Can Food Drive Race to End Hunger Student and Grade Level Incentives

- Week 1 Incentive: (November 5th - 10th)

 - The grade level that brings in the most items on average per student the first week will earn an ice cream party. (Each \$1 collected equals 2 items)
- Week 2 Incentive: (November 12th - 16th)
 - Any individual student that brings in 30 cans or \$15 dollars during Week 2 (cut off is Friday at 8:00am) will be awarded an Out of Uniform Day on Monday, November 19th
 - The grade level that brings in the most items on average per student the second week will receive a pizza party. (Each \$1 collected equals 2 items)
- Overall Incentive: (November 5th - 16th)
 - The grade level that brings in the most items on average per student for both weeks will earn a field trip (Date and location TBD) as well as The 2018 St Mark Catholic School Food Drive T-Shirt! (Each \$1 collected equals 2 items)
