



St. Mark Catholic School Admission Policy for Kindergarten Class

The following guidelines will be used to determine admission to Kindergarten class if there are more students enrolled than there are spots available. Priority will be based on the following:

1. Student that attended Pre-Kindergarten class the previous year at SMCS, whose family is considered a registered active parishioners at St. Mark Parish*, and that have siblings currently at, or have graduated from, St. Mark Catholic School
2. Student that attended Pre-Kindergarten class the previous year at SMCS, and whose family is a registered active parishioners at St. Mark Parish
3. Student whose family is a registered active parishioners at St. Mark Parish and that have siblings currently at, or have graduated from, St. Mark Catholic School
4. Student whose family is a registered active parishioners at St. Mark Parish
5. Student that attended Pre-Kindergarten class the previous year at SMCS whose family is not currently registered at St. Mark Parish and has siblings attending SMCS.
6. Student that attended Pre-Kindergarten class the previous year at SMCS whose family is not currently registered at St. Mark Parish
7. All other students.

St. Mark Catholic School Admission Policy for Pre-Kindergarten Class

The following guidelines will be used to determine admission to Pre-Kindergarten class if there are more students enrolled than there are spots available. Priority will be based on the following:

1. Student that attended Pre-Kindergarten class the previous year at SMCS
2. Student whose family is considered a registered active parishioners at St. Mark Parish*, and that have siblings currently at, or have graduated from, St. Mark Catholic School
3. Student whose family is a registered active parishioners at St. Mark Parish
4. Students whose family is not currently registered at St. Mark Parish and has siblings attending SMCS.
5. Student whose family is not currently registered at St. Mark Parish

*Registered Active Parishioner at St. Mark Parish is defined as:

1. A family that is registered in the parish office.
2. A family that attends weekend Masses at St. Mark with their family.
3. A family that participates in tithing to the St. Mark Church in weekly collections.
