Weekly COVID Update

During the week of December 14th - December 18th, St Mark Catholic School had zero positive COVID cases.

Updated COVID Guidance from Marion County Department of Health:

- If you are considered a close contact to someone who tested positive for COVID, the length of the quarantine period has been shortened to 10 days beginning from the last date of contact.
 - During the 10 days, you must remain symptom free; otherwise a full 14 day quarantine period must be completed.
 - If further close contact cannot be avoided (ex: a COVID positive parent providing ongoing care for their child), then the 10 day quarantine period begins after the 10 day contagious period of the COVID positive individual (20 day total quarantine period for the close contact).

Please continue to communicate with the school any household illnesses, COVID testing status, or close contact status.
